PRESIDENT'S REPORT – 2023 SEASON

Junior Program

In 2023, our junior program continued its sustained success. We increased our overall number of junior teams by 7 and ran successfully in all grades. Our total junior teams – 71 exceeded our previously captured high of 69 in 1994. There is a lot to celebrate in our continued growth for the juniors, as these players will turn into our senior league players into the future.

We also returned to the State Winter Championships, entering;

- 3 teams in the Under 12's, finishing first (DV pool 1), first (CW pool 2), and second (RD pool 1)
- 3 teams in the Under 14's, finishing third (DV) and equal fourth (CW & RD)
- 4 teams in the Under 16's, finishing first (DV pool 1), second (DV pool 2), third (CW pool 1), and eight (RD pool 1).

Unfortunately, the Under 18's were called off due to weather and ground conditions.

This year, we only had 1 elected officer in the Junior competitions – Mark Riches from the City West league. As always, Mark put himself out to help, and contributed more than 1 person should have to – although it's from his love of the game (and he frankly probably will continue to put his hand up to help even with more help).

It is vital that we get more people putting their hands up to help for the competition. I would like to thank not only Mark Riches, but also Nat Kilby and Ellie Every from Ringwood District and Diamond Valley respectively for stepping up and assisting where they could.

Neither Nat nor Ellie were elected to board in 2023, after previously serving to help the clubs, but needing to spend some (well deserved) time away from the board. Both of these superstars stepped up when coming up to the tournaments, and organised their respective areas at the last minute, to ensure the juniors could have successful tournaments in the State Winter Championships. It cannot be understated the amount of time and effort they both put in when they saw the need to help. It is a credit to them and their families.

However, we cannot and should not rely on the same volunteers every year coming in to assist at the last minute. If you know someone (or even yourself) that can step in and assist, we would love to talk to them.

Womens Program

The MWBL Women's program continued its growth, moving to 9 teams this winter. Well guided by Megan Kelly as the Women's Vice President, we are looking to continue this growth.

As the season went on, we were able to adapt and adjust some rules to allow for better game play and ensure fairness and enjoyment for all.

2023 also saw the initiation of the State Winter Championships for the Women's program. Held the same weekend as the men's competition, this initiative was very successful, and we look forward to continuing to support the program.

Seniors Program

The Senior Competition in 2023, much like the juniors has once again grown, moving from 107 teams entered to 118.

The competition was played in good spirits, although challenged by ground conditions and availability. Congratulations to all division winners, and respective MVPs on the season, and enjoy the accolades. They are all well deserved.

Of special note, Doncaster, returning to A Grade in 2023 has won both A-Grade and A-Reserve, after winning both B-Grade and B-Reserve in 2022. This is a feat that I do not believe has ever previously occurred in the VWBL / MWBL. Congratulations to the club for such a successful season.

For the State Winter Championships, the MWBL was only able to send away 1 team to Geelong. This is very disappointing, and we must work harder to help re-establish this tournament, and continue the traditions as we move forward, or we risk losing the Senior tournament altogether. We are now calling for volunteers to help us drive this program, in particular for the Ringwood and Diamond Valley areas.

Umpires

In 2023, the Umpires panel, led by Geoff Dunn and working with David Welsh established a new training concept, with umpire training running at local hubs around the competition.

This was met with great success, with club volunteers sitting through the training and some taking up the task of umpiring local games.

It is vitally important that we continue these strategies to increase umpiring numbers, as the numbers around the league are much lower than we would like, and the players would like.

Grounds

A lot of clubs this year faced some large challenges presented by items outside of their control. Namely the weather and the playing conditions at their grounds.

2023 saw a major uptick in the number of rescheduled / relocated games, with grounds being deemed unplayable, and needing to be moved.

I'd like to put a special thank you to the non-MWBL clubs who put their hand up to host games despite not having teams or seasons established. These include Baseball Victoria – for the use of Altona, Melbourne Baseball Club – hosting Doncaster and Watsonia, and Upwey Ferntree Gully Baseball Club – hosting Ringwood and Forest Hill.

Whilst we always hope weather won't play a part in games from year to year, inevitably it will. Anything clubs can do to assist with ensuring games can be played would be a benefit to all involved – and now is the time to talk to councils. All councils were hit across all sports around field availability last year, with the wet weather, so whilst they may have a lot on their plate, I would suggest conversations could and should be initiated to investigate options around all-weather playing surfaces, such as full turf fields. This would help improve your facilities and also reduce council upkeep on the fields. If you haven't started talking to your council, now is a great time to initiate the conversation.

Communications

This year we undertook a change to our communications strategy. We worked with The Content Engine to help us establish a more committed approach to a Social Media strategy, and work on our communications in general. We signed the engagement in June, and TCE initiated content production towards the end of June.

This engagement saw some great success in our engagement, with Game of the Round coverage, player of the round, and generally a lot more posts and engagement on our social media and web presence.

From this period, we were able to see a large growth in our Facebook reach, but also started building an Instagram page that we previously didn't have.

This has given us a very positive start to our journey into effective communication – with some exciting initiatives under consideration for 2024!

Financials

The MWBL has continued with a strong financial position in 2023. As we move forward, we are looking to continue to invest into the development of the league, increasing the engagement in the existing playing group, and increasing participation and engagement outside of the existing stakeholders.

This will be a hard task, but the work that has been put into the league by all who have come before us, have set up the league with a strong financial position, that allows us to launch these initiatives, and support the clubs.

Thank You's

I would like to thank all the volunteers from 2023. Firstly, to the MWBL Board, who all put in their personal time to ensure the league continues to function and grow.

To the non-Board members who put up their time, whether asked or not. The help and work that you put in is instrumental in helping move the league forward, and ensuring the players and clubs have a good experience.

Michael Chambers, as the League Administrator, continues to work extremely hard, and between him and David Rice this year, the amount of extra time put into relocating games, to ensure as many games could be played as possible was phenomenal.

David Rice – as a special call out. David has put in countless hours over the years. He puts his hand up to contribute in any way that we need assistance, produces and reproduces fixtures until we can finalise the grade entries, works through Finals Fixturing, and also works through all requirements of the being the Chair of the Pennant Committee. Without the time and effort, he has put in over the history of the VWBL/MWBL, we would not be where we are today.

For the clubs, I would like to thank all committee/board members, and volunteers that are working within each club. It is not an easy task to run a baseball club, with so much work, and requirements, but low income and support from some key stakeholders. We appreciate the efforts you are all making and look forward to continuing to work with you in 2024.

2024 Challenges

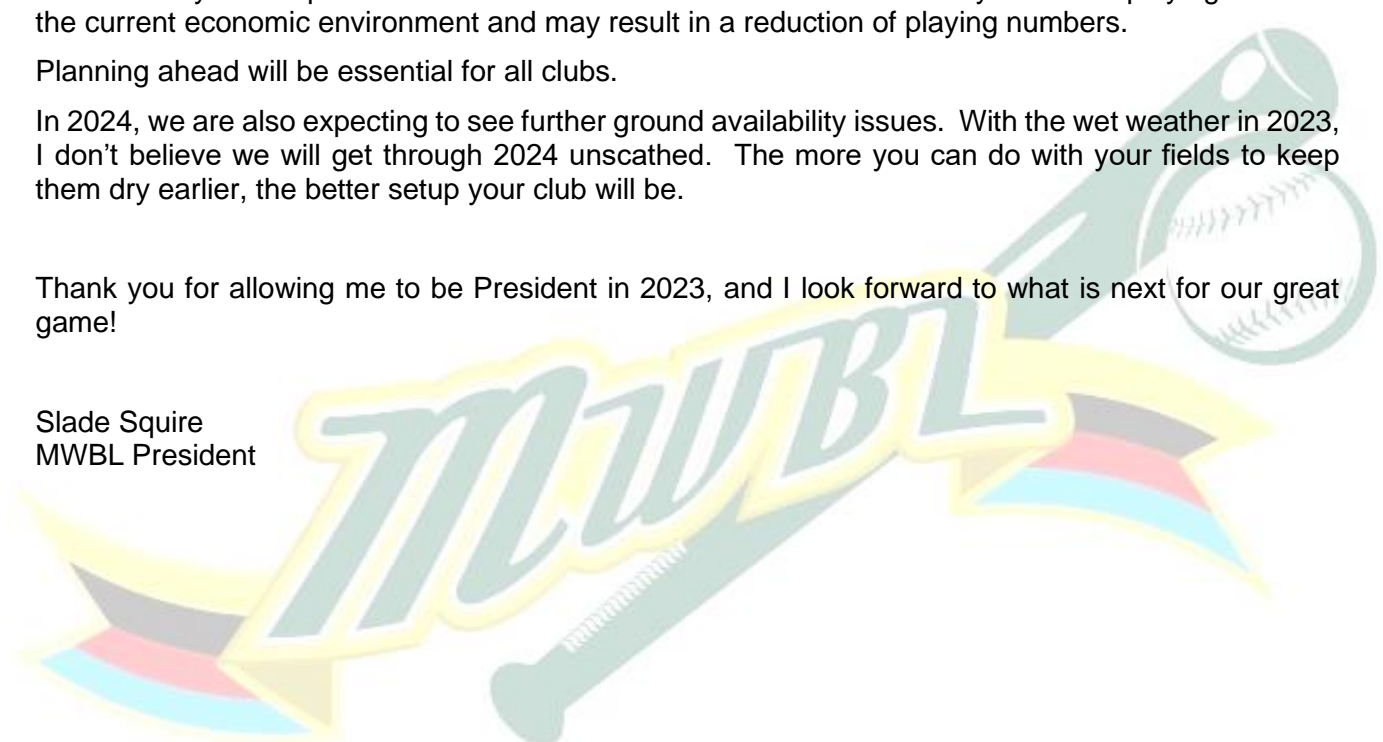
The challenges facing us for 2024 have increased but are not insurmountable. Unfortunately, Baseball Victoria has raised capitation (fees) for senior player registration by nearly 225%, moving from \$42.60 to \$95.69 per player. This increase has been levied without any consultation from Baseball Victoria, and with very little explanation. These increases in costs will undoubtedly affect the playing cohort in the current economic environment and may result in a reduction of playing numbers.

Planning ahead will be essential for all clubs.

In 2024, we are also expecting to see further ground availability issues. With the wet weather in 2023, I don't believe we will get through 2024 unscathed. The more you can do with your fields to keep them dry earlier, the better setup your club will be.

Thank you for allowing me to be President in 2023, and I look forward to what is next for our great game!

The Annual General Meeting was held in December 2022 with elections conducted as required and appointments made as necessary for the management of the MWBL for the 2023 season as listed in the report.

The League also welcomed the expansion of the women's competition with the inclusion of additional teams from Melbourne Uni and North Balwyn, bringing the number of teams to 9.

Thank you to the MWBL Board members and sub-committees for help throughout the season. Thanks to the Clubs and their administrators for their co-operation and help through the season in the overall administration of the league.

Thanks to the Pennant Committee chair David Rice and the other pennant committee members for their deliberations and decision making that is needed during a busy season. Thanks to Geoff Dunn (Chair), David Welsh (Development) and Denis Dalzotto (Secretary) the MWBL Umpires panel executive for their help in administration of the umpires and the umpires for officiating of games.

Results and ladders for senior and junior competitions were updated on Sunday mornings for the clubs and player information. The emailing of game scores and match sheets is working well. The checking and signing of match sheets by managers in the lower grades are still an issue as is the awarding of MVP votes.

I look forward to the 2024 season and working with all our affiliated clubs.

PENNANT COMMITTEE REPORT - 2023 SEASON.

The 2023 season started well with team nominations back to pre-covid numbers and with some late team inclusions finished with 118 senior and 71 junior teams taking the field.

After fine weather for the first couple of weeks a rain event then caused cancelation of some games which is not usual at that time of the season.

As the team numbers finalised after about three rounds allowing for fixtures to be sorted for most grades with thirteen senior men's grades, one women's grade and twelve junior grades.

The Match conditions were again scrutinised and amended to try to simplify as well as adding rules applicable to the women's competition.

Clubs were given the opportunity to nominate teams in grades and have input into the match conditions as well as other on field issues directly or at the regular monthly zoom meetings.

The pennant committee dealt with issues as they occurred during the season and in particular the large number of junior dispensations at the season start.

In August the wet weather again washed out a number of grounds just before the finals making it difficult to schedule in particular the semifinals and some junior games. The decision was made to try to use the grounds that recover the best after rain regardless of the clubs involved and to play double headers and use lights where possible.

Except for some junior semifinals all senior finals games and junior grand finals were able to be completed

Thank you to all those clubs that allowed their grounds to be used for finals even though they were not playing in the games and for the preparation of the grounds.

Thanks, the pennant committee members, Peter Dihm, Julie Jones, Telen Stanfield, and Luis Mayo for your adjudication at times difficult issues that have to be dealt with and also Michael Chambers the league administrator for his work with the pennant committee.

Thanks as well to the MWBL Board members for their input and decisions that need to be made throughout the season.

WOMEN'S LEAGUE – 2023 SEASON REPORT

This year saw the MWBL women's competition grow from six to nine teams. This year was our second year since the women's competitions transition from the Dandenong Baseball Association, and the competition seems to be going from strength to strength. It's been very promising to see more women's teams registering for the MWBL and an increase in the quality of the competition.

Congratulations to North Balwyn Hornets for taking home the premiership and to the Southeast Warriors for a strong season. Thank you to Latrobe University for hosting our final series. Congratulations also to Vic Brown (Melbourne University) for the League MVP for the season.

Both North Balwyn and Melbourne University entered two women's teams this year, it has been great to see the growth of women's programs at these two clubs and across the league. In future seasons, we will be looking to recruit enough teams to be able to make two divisions to allow the teams to compete against teams of similar skill levels.

To adjust to the unique needs of our women's programs throughout the season, we experimented with the addition of two new rules: one to support developing pitchers by allowing them to pitch from the front of the mound, and another to support teams running low on players to recruit players from teams that have a bye. We will be seeking feedback on the effectiveness of these rules at the start of next season. We hope that these rules helped teams to prevent forfeits and to increase the quality of the games and overall experiences for developing players.

We also sent our first women's team to the State Winter Championship at Geelong Baseball Club in June 2023. Our team placed third, but it was a great weekend of baseball with a friendly mix of junior and senior baseballers from across our league's teams. We're looking forward to coordinating a team for next year's tournament with more notice and preparation to get more players involved, so watch this space!

A couple of thank you's are in order:

- To the Women's Delegates for their time, feedback, and communication with their playing groups. We have been working to streamline communications and promote collaboration between our teams, and it feels like everything is on the right track.
- To Mick Chambers for his support and guidance as we grow this competition.
- To the consistent and friendly roster of umpires who support our competition, you add to the community feel of our competition.
- To all volunteers who helped to get our games up and running each Sunday.

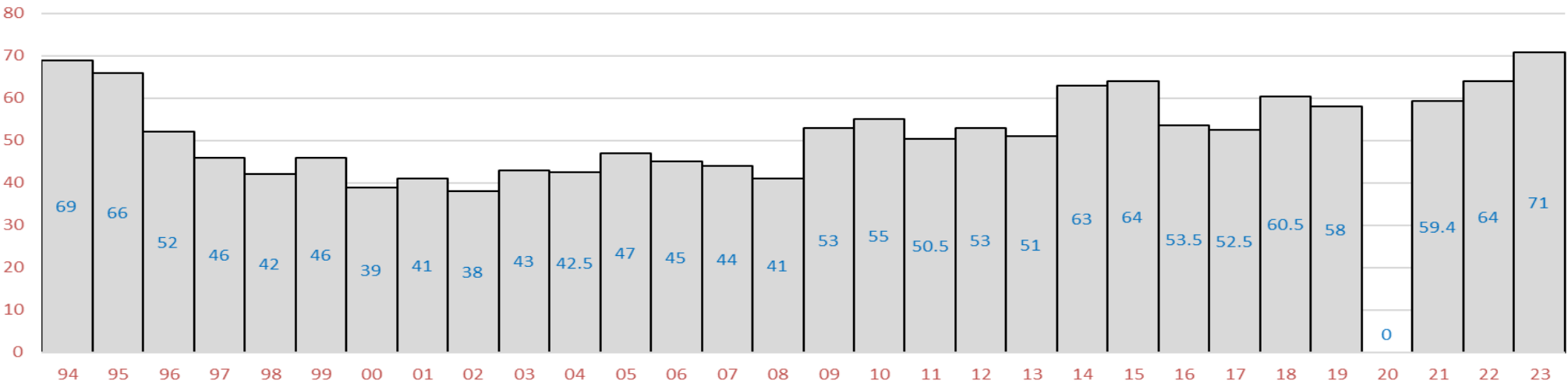
