PRESIDENT'S REPORT – 2019 SEASON

I am pleased to report on another successful year in the MWBL. This year has turned into a changeover year for us as our Administrator for the past seventeen years (David and Anne Rice) have decided to reduce their baseball work load.

This necessitated us implementing our succession plan. We advertised for a new Administrator and after an in-depth process we appointed Michael Chambers to the role. Michael has worked in the role as a development exercise in conjunction with David and Anne and will go solo as of the Annual Meeting. This transition process has been very effective and we believe that this is amplified by the fact that next season will continue in the same smooth fashion you our member clubs are use too.

However, David is not totally lost to us as he will continue to undertake the tough task of fixturing, and is prepared to work in other volunteer roles within the organization.

I would like to thank David and Anne for the great job they have undertaken for in their time in the Administrators roles

This season also sees another of our long term volunteers stepping down Phil Barclay is leaving after twenty three years as a committee person and Vice President of the MWBL. Phil's knowledge and organization skills have ensured the smooth running of the Ringwood District Juniors. Whilst overall our junior numbers have not grown as we would have wished the solution is more complicated than just recruiting and Phil has worked hard in dealing with those issues.

On behalf of the League I would like to thank Phil all the best and thank him for a great contribution to our sport and League.

Again we continue to run into trouble with BA and BV over their Little League and other junior competitions that continually overlap with our season. This situation leads to elite coaches scheduling training sessions when our games are on and they insist on the kids training instead of playing. All of these activities impact on our junior numbers as there are ongoing trials and training sessions for these programs and parents either commit to scheduled playing competitions or the other activities. However, the demand is too great both in time and cost for Parents to commit to both.

What BA fail to recognize is that Victoria Winter competitions (when taken together) are the biggest leagues in the Country in terms of overall player registrations as well as geographical spread. As far as the Governing Bodies are concerned the world revolves around their summer state league competitions.

What they all fail to recognize is that "WE" are the sport not just one part of it – the WE being all of us not just one group. My question to BA and BV is why exclude us and not let us run out own charters in conjunction with their charters?

This year saw Baseball Victoria organize a winter associations delegates meeting again. Whilst these continue to be a step in the right direction, it is still not enough. They scheduled the meeting during the senior Winter Championships and only allocated about four hours for the meeting. Further the BV Board continue to snub (for want of a better word) by the continual absence of Baseball Victoria Board members from these meetings. It is unfortunate that the BV Board lack the understanding and insight into the biggest numbers of their participating membership. Very few members of the BV Board could tell you anything about the Winter programs, let alone recognize the contribution the Winter members make to baseball in this state yet they continue to make decisions that impact on our Leagues..

In relation to recruiting and retention we need to be more inventive. Certainly the move to integrate a full Women's program as part of our compulsory team allocation is a step in the right direction. I must praise our clubs who instigated their school programs. It became very clear and evident that the only way to enhance the recruiting of players through local schools is for the relevant Clubs to build a relationship with the schools is by having Club personnel involved.

President's Report – 2019 Continued

It is important to recognize the achievement of the Diamond Valley Juniors who this coming will be commencing their 60th season. I happen to know a bit about this as I played in the inaugural seasons. So this is also my 60th year of continual involvement in this great sport of ours. I also might add that the first two Premierships in the DVJ competition were won by Montmorency (now GMBC) and I was fortunate to play in both.

Anyway, enough nostalgia for now. However, I believe that as a group, we should recognize this great achievement of DVJ and perhaps a "reunion dinner" might provide our Clubs the opportunity to invite a lot of past players and members back to celebrate the occasion and give them the opportunity to reconnect with our great sport.

The winter campaign for our representative teams, with all junior age groups performing well. The City Diamond Valley and Ringwood District teams represented us at senior level. It is great credit to the coaching and management staff of the teams that they performed very well. It is very exciting that Diamond Valley were able to get a senior team into the field. Let's hope it continues.

Congratulations to the Junior sections for getting teams on the field that are competitive and represent our League with pride

Again this year we had a sponsored day for our League at the Aces. Whilst there are some among you who don't agree with this aspect of our activities, I believe that this is very much an appropriate activity for us to participate in. We have a large number of our junior groups participate in the day's activities and it is a big thrill for them to play in front of the Aces. In addition they get to be up close and personal with the Aces players and staff. It allows them to identify with these people and enables them to see what is possible in our great sport. Currently we are funding this activity out of our "fine money" and I could not think of a better use of this money that you all give to us so generously because of your inability to follow the basis requirements.

I would rather see our fine money spent this way than have it absorbed into general revenue. At least you get some value and positives for your simple mistakes.

Like all sporting leagues, there is a turnover of committees, and this is no different for the MWBL. However, we have a solid and dedicated board. Thanks to Phil Barclay, Slade Squire, Matt Nichol, Geoff Dunne, Michael Chambers and Shannon Crawford for providing a strong Administrative support to our League.

Also thanks to the members of the Pennant Committee and Tribunal as well as the Report Review Person. Their work is essential to the smooth operation of our Association.

I wish to acknowledge the premier teams and MVP's for all grades as listed later in this report.

In conclusion I would like to thank you the Clubs for your continued support.

The league increased to 110 senior teams with an increase of 2 teams over last year but a disappointing decrease in junior teams to 53 teams due to Baseball Victoria's continuing summer elite junior programs during the winter season

To the premierships that were won by the teams in the ten senior and seven junior competitions are to be congratulated and are recorded later in this report .

Thank you to the MWBL Board members and the various sub-committees for help throughout the season. Thanks to the Clubs and their administrators and others for their co-operation and help throughout the season in the increasing demanding administration of the league. The continuing issue of player registrations with the Baseball Australia registration system still remains an annoying issue for the clubs and league. Fixtures for the lower senior grades take up a great deal of time to be completed with clubs teams adding and withdrawing as the season progresses.

Thanks to the Geoff Dunn (chair), Richard Mason (Development), Denis Dalzotto (Secretary) the MWBL Umpires panel executive for their assistance in the administration of the umpires as well as the umpire appointments to games. Thank you to all the umpires throughout the season in the officiating of games. To Pennant Committee chair Matt Nichol and the other pennant members, thanks for their time and efforts and decision making that are needed through the season especially during this year's difficult weather interruptions to the finals games.

Minimal amendments were made by the pennant committee to the 'Playing and Match Conditions' for both seniors and juniors Match Conditions with booklets printed prior to the start of the season and distributed to clubs and players.

Results and ladders for the senior and junior competitions were updated on Sunday mornings for the clubs and players. This year the league introduced that all match results and match sheets to be emailed to the league administrator which after some initial hiccups proved to work well.

Clubs Attendance at delegates and coaches meetings was not bad this year with small number of clubs not attending and prefer to pay the fine remain an issue.

As this will be my last Annual Report after seventeen years I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the MWBL board members and clubs for their help and assistance over the years for which I have been privileged to have been involved with and the way the league has grown to be one of the best administered leagues in the country

PENNANT COMMITTEE REPORT - 2019 SEASON.

The Melbourne Winter Baseball League's 2019 season was another successful year for baseball. Our three junior leagues and senior competitions in metropolitan Melbourne facilitate participation in baseball for people with a range of skills and experience. The Pennant Committee hopes that the Melbourne Winter Baseball League will be able to provide further opportunities to play winter baseball by commencing a women's competition in the near future.

The season began with the regular fixturing issues in the lower grades flowing from fluctuations in team entries. The result was an expansion of D and D reserve grades into two geographic divisions: north and south. Feedback received by the league was that this format worked well and helped to minimise travel time for teams. Other senior and junior grades had minimal fixturing problems.

The junior and senior competitions operated without too many major issues. However, the Pennant Committee received reports from two clubs involving separate incidents at a senior and a junior game. The resulting investigations and hearings by the Pennant Committee saw penalties imposed on clubs and players.

In addition to the annual meeting with club coaches held at the start of the season, the Pennant Committee ran for the first time a second coaches' meeting prior to the finals. This meeting was used to provide information to coaches related to finals rules, umpire appointments and fixturing. Useful feedback was received from coaches on potential rule changes for the 2020 season, which will be considered by the new Pennant Committee.

The operation of finals in all grades this year presented a number of administrative challenges that will need to be addressed for next season. The combination of limited ground availability and the issue of home field advantage affected fixturing in all three rounds of finals. Rain also required the rescheduling of the A and B grade grand finals. The hosting of finals and the suitability of the fields at La Trobe University BC and Doncaster BC will be reviewed by the incoming Pennant Committee for the 2020 season.

Finally, I would like to thank Richard Mason and Andrew Rose for their contribution to this year's Pennant Committee, David Rice for his work and contribution to the League, the Melbourne Winter Baseball League board for their support and the clubs for their willingness to engage on issues before the Pennant Committee.

For the domestic competition, the number of teams remained strong over the 2019 season, Rookie Ball once again running with four teams on the Greensborough ground (thank you again to GBC for their assistance and making their ground available).

Thank you to the organisers for the Rookie Ball, it was again very well run, as they determined a suitable structure, that allowed for development, advancement of skills, but most importantly... Fun. In the Under 13 competition – we were able to improve our numbers dramatically, and created a new problem... Not enough grounds at our currently location. The introduction of a new teams from La Trobe University, and Greensborough fielding a full team, it's a great challenge to have, and is something we are reviewing over the summer, trying to locate options for us to keep the games running in a centre format. This year, we were able to cover the ground allocations with home games being played at club clubs, but (with any luck), this is not something that will be able to continue, as we continue to strengthen the under 17 and under 15 grades.

Under 15's continued with the Home & Away format – a format I believe has been very successful, providing clubs the opportunity to have more of their juniors playing home games, and playing on the main diamonds. This year, due to team numbers and competition make up, we determined to join the Ringwood and Diamond Valley under 15 competition, then divide up into three divisions towards the end of the year. The under 17's once again joined in with the Ringwood District and this lead to an immediate setup of Division 1 and Division 2, allowing for a great competition for the season, and another successful year.

The continued growth of the DVJBA is due to the dedicated volunteers at the clubs, and the work that people put in to continue to drive the influx of new players. It is however, the first in a small stepping stone of how we need to continue to grow our sport. As a smaller sport, we cannot lapse on the intensity of the promotion of the sport we all love.

The 2020 season will be very telling as we look to improve our position, and bring more kids into the sport we love. I would like to encourage all clubs to consider working together, and potentially setting up a working group, to discuss how we can improve the promotion of the sport as a whole, working towards a stronger league.
