As we conclude the 2024 Winter Baseball season, I am filled with gratitude and pride, particularly as the first female President of the Melbourne Winter Baseball League. This year, we faced issues where some members actively undermined, recruited, and colluded against select executive committee members. In response, the executive committee convened multiple times to address these issues, resulting in difficult but necessary decisions and sanctions for future seasons. As the largest winter baseball league in Victoria, we must take a firm stance to ensure a safe and inclusive environment for all.

On a brighter note, the MWBL has seen a steady increase in membership and participation across all age groups since 2023. Here are some highlights:

- Junior Competition increased 16.9% from 71 teams in 2023 to 83 in 2024
- Women's Competition increased 22.2% from 9 teams in 2023 to 11 in 2024.
- Senior Competition increased from 6.7% from 118 in 2023 to 126 in 2024.

The Victorian Winter State Championships were a highlight, with the MWBL sending its largest number of participants to date, including senior and junior teams. This growth reflects the dedication of our community, and I am excited to build on this momentum as we move into the next season.

Together, let's continue to foster a positive and inclusive environment for all members of the Melbourne Winter Baseball League. Thank you for your unwavering commitment, and here's to a successful 2025 season!

Thank you to the MWBL Board members and sub-committees for help throughout the season. Thanks to the Clubs and their administrators for their co-operation and help through the season in the overall administration of the league.

Thanks to the Pennant Committee chair David Rice and the other pennant committee members for their deliberations and decision making that is needed during a busy season. Thanks to Geoff Dunn (Chair), David Welsh (Development) and Denis Dalzotto (Secretary) the MWBL Umpires panel executive for their help in administration of the umpires and the umpires for officiating of games.

The emailing of game scores and match sheets is working well. The checking and signing of match sheets by managers in the lower grades are still an issue as is the awarding of MVP votes.

I look forward to the 2025 season and working with all our affiliated clubs.

PENNANT COMMITTEE REPORT - 2024 SEASON.

The 2024 season got off to a disrupted start due to not having a working web site for clubs and players to be able to view the fixtures due to the current web site not being compatible with the Baseball Victoria 'Game Day' competition management program that only became evident just prior to the season start with senior and junior fixtures having to be sent to clubs by email which took about a month to rectify.

Team entries continued to grow with a number of teams added after the season started especially in the seniors which resulted fixtures having to be redone a number of times in the lower grades as teams were added and moved between the grades.

For the season clubs entered 127 senior teams a nine team increase in 13 men's grades and 2 women's grades with 79 junior teams and increase of 8 teams in 14 different competitions.

As usual clubs were able to nominate teams in the various senior and junior grades with teams added and withdrawn up to round three needing the pennant committee to grade and then regrade teams.

Clubs were also able to have input with on field issues during the season with the monthly zoom meetings.

Match conditions were amended as required by the pennant committee to accord with the clubs wishes. The pennant committee had to deal with a number of issues throughout the season in particular club's that did not comply with the MWBL match conditions and had to fine, take points off and put bonds on clubs. Unfortunately, two teams were not able to play in grand finals due to playing ineligible players. Also had to deal with a many junior dispensations at start of the season.

In the middle of July the pennant committee had to call off the whole senior round due to wet weather that blanketed Melbourne. The league has not had to do this for at least 25 years. Fortunately, the weather improved just in time for most grounds to be available to allow for the senior and junior finals series to be completed.

To the clubs that allowed grounds to be used for the finals thank you, even though not competing in games and for the work undertaken in preparation of the fields

My thanks to the pennant committee members Julie Jones, Peter Dihm and Luis Mayo and other members of the MWBL board for their input and decision making that needed dealt with.

Thanks to the league Administrator Michael Chambers for all his hard work in conjunction with the pennant committee and in particular fixtures

Thank you to the MWBL Board members for at times difficult decision making and issues that arose though the season.

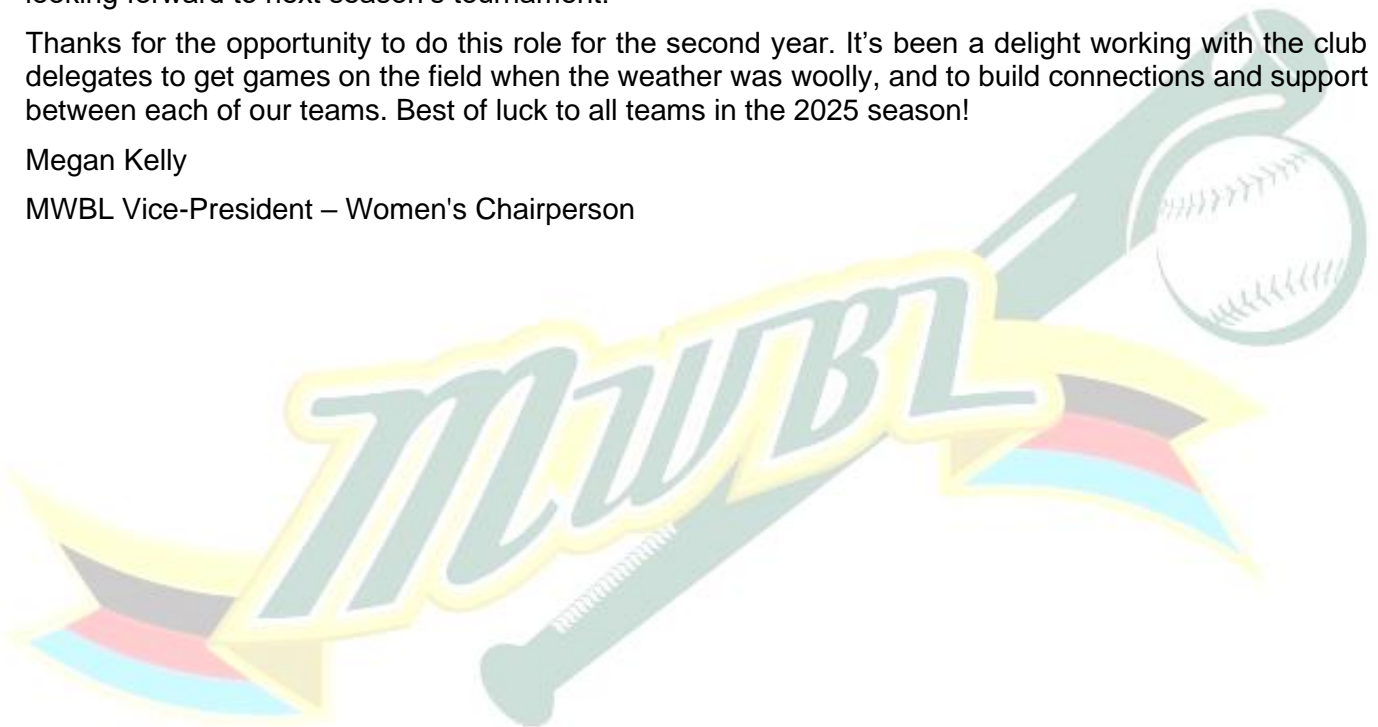

Setting up a chat group between Club delegates and the DV President was received with open arms by the Clubs and some good discussions came out of this chat group. This will remain an essential tool moving forward to allow the flow of information and suggestions to better improve our sport.

As a person in this position for the first time I found the other members of the Board to be very helpful and I especially thank the efforts of Natalie Kilby from Ringwood District, who really led the way and provided a blueprint for all of us to follow to make our presence felt in the baseball community.

The season itself had many challenges for the MWBL and overall I believe from a Diamond Valley perspective most of the challenges were met and resolved. One of the challenges was, how do we get more usage out of Chris Lane Field. This is a purpose built Little League Diamond that essentially was not being utilised as much as it should be. This diamond should and will be utilised more in the coming seasons and this is great for the sport of Baseball.

This season also saw a bit of an upgrade for Mill Park. In years past the amenities were less than desirable at this venue and it has taken a lot of effort by our Secretary of the MWBL Sally Friend to champion the cleaning up of this venue. For quite a number of weeks Sally took it upon herself to make sure the amenities were clean and tidy and useable. This became too much of a job and cleaners were appointed to continue cleaning the amenities. Something that will continue in the future.

Now onto the representative season.

Diamond Valley once again showed up in force, fielding a large number of rep teams across all age groups. A big thankyou to our President Elli Every who helped me get the word out to Clubs that we wanted as many players as possible represent Diamond Valley. The reason for this was twofold. Over previous seasons there seemed to be a decline in players wanting to play Winter State Championships as they had so many options available to them to play elsewhere. We want to make the Winter State Championships the flagship Winter tournament and I think we achieved this. The other reason was to get as many players, who in previous seasons never had an opportunity to play rep ball, get a chance to experience the next level.

The result of our efforts culminated in DV fielding 2 U12; 3 U14; 2 U16 and 1 U18 teams. Out of these teams our U14 and U16 Div1 teams came away with Championship wins and our U16 Div 2 team took second place.

I would like to thank all the Coaches and support staff for all teams. Without you the challenge we set ourselves to manage 8 teams would not have happened. Whilst it was tough at times, I believe all players enjoyed the experience and will be back next year representing DV again.

Finally, I want to thank all the volunteers and Club officials without whom the season would not happen. It is with your hard work and dedication to the sport that we as a League would not be as strong as it is without you. I hope to work with you all next season and I am already working hard to make season 2025 better than 2024.

SECRETARY REPORT

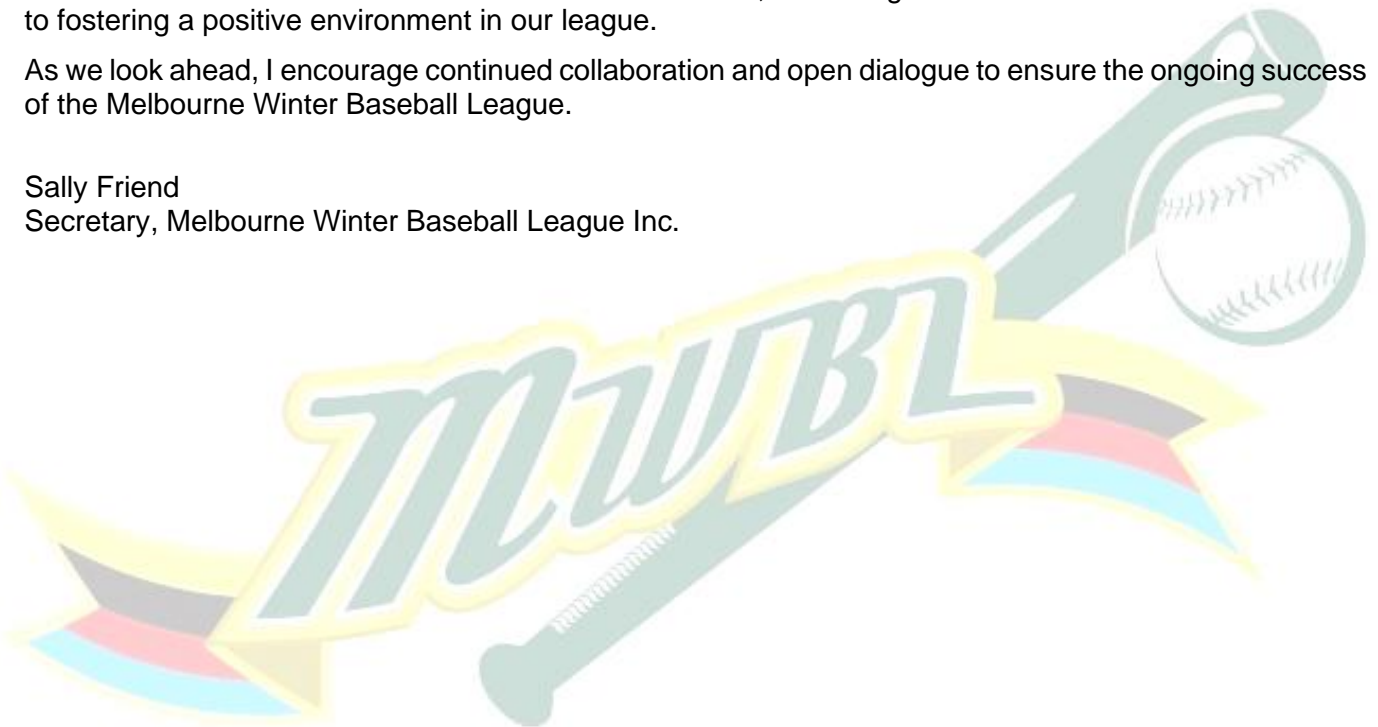

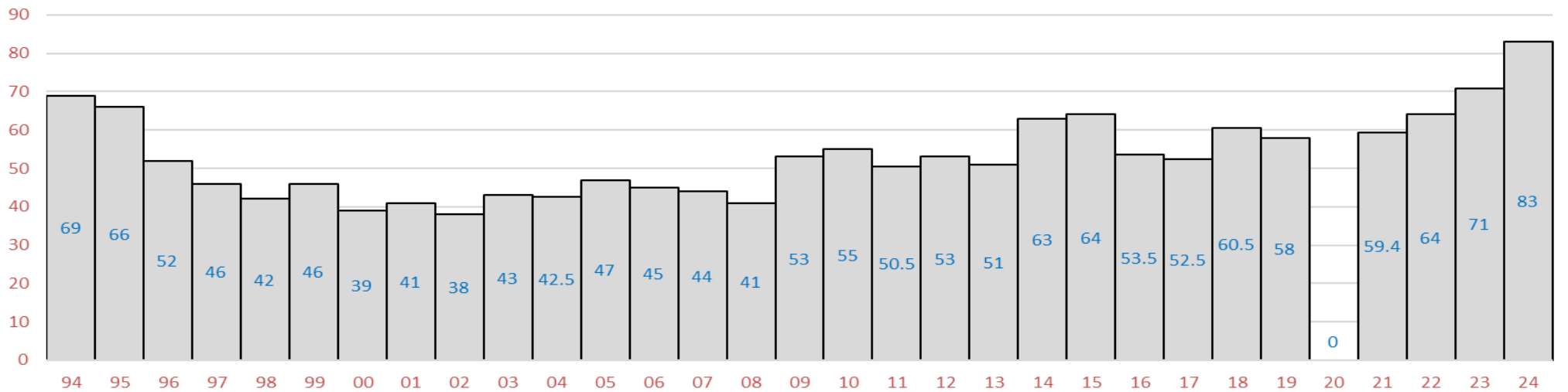
